

## Birches, Poplars & Willows, page 1:

<b>Variety:</b>	<b>Crimson Frost Birch</b>	<i>Betula 'Crimson Frost'</i>	<b>Zone: 4</b>
<b>H x W:</b>	25-35' x 20-25'	<b>Foliage/Fall Color:</b>	Burgundy foliage all summer and fall
<b>Form:</b>	Upright	<b>Bark:</b>	White with cinnamon highlights, exfoliates with age
<b>Other Info:</b>	This is an excellent specimen tree for areas with moist, heavy soils. The contrasting effect of foliage and bark is very appealing.		

<b>Variety:</b>	<b>Heritage Birch</b>	<i>Betula nigra 'Cully'</i>	<b>Zone: 4</b>
<b>H x W:</b>	45-50' x 30-35'	<b>Foliage/Fall Color:</b>	Glossy green, becoming gold in the fall
<b>Form:</b>	Oval	<b>Bark:</b>	White to tan, exfoliating bark
<b>Other Info:</b>	This award winning tree tolerates both heavy and light soils, and is resistant to the Bronze Birch Borer.		

<b>Variety:</b>	<b>Prairie Dream Paper Birch</b>	<i>Betula papyrifera 'Varen'</i>	<b>Zone: 2</b>
<b>H x W:</b>	50' x 40'	<b>Foliage/Fall Color:</b>	Dark green, turning gold in the fall
<b>Form:</b>	Broad, oval	<b>Bark:</b>	Snow white bark, exfoliates as the tree matures
<b>Other Info:</b>	Here is a great paper birch out of North Dakota that resists Bronze Birch Borers and tolerates stress very well.		

<b>Variety:</b>	<b>Renaissance Reflection Birch</b>	<i>Betula papyrifera 'renci'</i>	<b>Zone: 3</b>
<b>H x W:</b>	60' x 25'	<b>Foliage/Fall Color:</b>	Green leaves turn bright yellow in fall
<b>Form:</b>	Pyramidal	<b>Bark:</b>	Bright white, exfoliating bark
<b>Other Info:</b>	This paper birch performs well in backyard settings. It grows quickly and tolerates heat well.		

<b>Variety:</b>	<b>Weeping Cutleaf Birch</b>	<i>Betula pendula 'Dalecarlica'</i>	<b>Zone: 2</b>
<b>H x W:</b>	30-40' x 25'	<b>Foliage/Fall Color:</b>	Deep green, turning gold in the fall
<b>Form:</b>	Weeping	<b>Bark:</b>	Brown, maturing to light gray with black grooves
<b>Other Info:</b>	It is hard to match the gracefulness of this finely textured, cascading tree.		

<b>Variety:</b>	<b>Young's Weeping Birch</b>	<i>Betula pendula 'Youngii'</i>	<b>Zone: 3</b>
<b>H x W:</b>	15-20' x 15'	<b>Foliage/Fall Color:</b>	Deep green, turning yellow in autumn
<b>Form:</b>	Weeping	<b>Bark:</b>	White, exfoliating
<b>Other Info:</b>	These are really unique trees that look stunning near water gardens. They perform best in moist, well-drained soils.		

<b>Variety:</b>	<b>Siouxland Poplar</b>	<i>Populus deltoides 'Siouxland'</i>	<b>Zone: 3</b>
<b>H x W:</b>	70-90' x 40'	<b>Foliage/Fall Color:</b>	Dark green, insignificant in the fall
<b>Form:</b>	Rounded	<b>Bark:</b>	Insignificant
<b>Other Info:</b>	'Siouxland' is a large-leaved, cotton-less cottonwood that thrives in moist soils.

Variety:	Columnar Swedish Aspen	<i>Populus tremula 'Erecta'</i>	Zone: 2
H x W:	40' x 10'	Foliage/Fall Color:	Dark green w/ silver underside, yellow in autumn
Form:	Columnar	Bark:	Insignificant
Other Info:	This canker-resistant tree is perfect for privacy screens and driveway canopies.		

Variety:	Quaking Aspen	<i>Populus tremuloides</i>	Zone: 2
H x W:	60-80' x 30'	Foliage/Fall Color:	Small, green w/ silver underside, lovely yellow in fall
Form:	Pyramidal to rounded	Bark:	Greenish-white
Other Info:	Tough, native and adaptable, Quaking Aspens are perfect for naturalizing tough areas. They make beautiful music in the breeze.		

Variety:	Prairie Sky Poplar	<i>Populus x canescens</i>	Zone: 3
H x W:	60-80' x 20'	Foliage/Fall Color:	Green, yellow in fall
Form:	Narrow, upright	Bark:	Insignificant
Other Info:	This poplar was developed at the Morden Research Center in Canada. It grows rapidly but is long lived and disease resistant.		

Variety:	Prairie Cascade Willow	<i>Salix 'Prairie Cascade'</i>	Zone: 3
H x W:	35-45' x 35-40'	Foliage/Fall Color:	Shiny green, golden yellow fall color
Form:	Weeping	Bark:	Golden yellow, attractive
Other Info:	Also developed at the Morden Research Center, this gorgeous tree is a hair smaller at maturity than traditional weeping willows.
