Variety:	Amur Maple- Tree	<i>Acer ginnala</i>	Zone: 3
H x W:	15-20' x 15'	Bloom Time:	April - May
Foliage:	Green	Flower Description:	Small, pale yellow, very fragrant
Fall Foliage:	Bright red with hints of orange and yellow	Fruit Description:	Samaras (helicopters), turn red in summer
Other Info:	Amur Maples are adaptable to a wide range of conditions. They offer excellent fall color and habitat for wildlife		

Variety:	Autumn Brilliance Serviceberry	<i>Amelanchier x grandiflora</i>	Zone: 3
H x W:	20-25' x 15'	Bloom Time:	Late April
Foliage:	Blue-green	Flower Description:	White, very showy for a short period
Fall Foliage:	Red-orange	Fruit Description:	dark purple, attractive and delicious
Other Info:	Serviceberries are tough, adaptable plants that provide food for people and wildlife. They also have great ornamental value.		

Variety:	Thornless Cockspur Hawthorn	<i>Crataegus crus-galli inermis</i>	Zone: 4
H x W:	15-20' x 15-20'	Bloom Time:	May - June
Foliage:	Glossy, dark green	Flower Description:	small clusters of 1/2", single, white flowers
Fall Foliage:	Gold to orange-red	Fruit Description:	3/8 - 1/2", dark red w/ silvery overlay
Other Info:	The best thing about this tree is its shiny, dark green foliage. Nice flowers, fruit and fall foliage are added bonuses.		

Variety:	Crimson Cloud Hawthorn	<i>Crataegus laevigata 'Superba'</i>	Zone:
H x W:	15' x 10-15'	Bloom Time:	Mid May
Foliage:	Green	Flower Description:	Single, red with white centers
Fall Foliage:	Insignificant	Fruit Description:	1/4" - 1/2", shiny, red fruit
Other Info:	This tree offers a uniquely beautiful floral display. Hawthorns tolerate dry soil, salt spray and juglone from black walnuts.		

Variety:	Prairie Radiance Euonymus	<i>Euonymus bungeana 'Verona'</i>	Zone: 3
H x W:	18-24' x 15-18'	Bloom Time:	May
Foliage:	Green	Flower Description:	1/4", yellow, no ornamental value
Fall Foliage:	Reddish	Fruit Description:	showy pink capsules with red arils
Other Info:	The fruits on these trees almost like the flowers of fuchsias when they pop open in September. Very attractive and different!		

Variety:	Crimson Point Plum	<i>Prunus x cerasifera 'Cripoizam'</i>	Zone: 4
H x W:	20-25' x 5-6'	Bloom Time:	Mid April
Foliage:	Bronze to burgundy	Flower Description:	Single, white, fragrant
Fall Foliage:	Bright maroon and green	Fruit Description:	Small, ornamental
Other Info:	Here is the latest, greatest, option for ornamental interest in a tight spot!

Variety:	Canada Red Cherry	<i>Prunus virginiana 'Shubert'</i>	Zone: 2
H x W:	20-25' x 20'	Bloom Time:	Late April - May
Foliage:	Green, turning burgundy in June	Flower Description:	2-6" long clusters of cream colored flowers
Fall Foliage:	Bright, red-burgundy	Fruit Description:	1-3", dark purple
Other Info:	The Canada Red Cherry has been popular for years, due to its burgundy foliage. Fruits can be used in baking and preserves.		

Variety:	Autumn Blaze Pear	<i>Pyrus calleryana</i>	Zone: 4
H x W:	35' x 20'	Bloom Time:	Early May
Foliage:	Green	Flower Description:	3/8 - 3/4", white
Fall Foliage:	Reddish purple	Fruit Description:	1/2", russet-colored, not showy or edible
Other Info:	'Autumn Blaze' is a nice, ornamental pear that offers attractive spring bloom and exceptional fall color.		

Variety:	Twisty Baby Locust	<i>Robinia pseudoacacia 'Lacy...'</i>	Zone: 4
H x W:	8-15' x 12-18'	Bloom Time:	May - June, flowers sparsely
Foliage:	Deep blue-green, twisted	Flower Description:	fragrant, white racemes, sweet pea like flowers
Fall Foliage:	Yellow, leaves drop early	Fruit Description:	sparse production of black seed pods
Other Info:	The most interesting thing about this tree are its contorted branches, which create year-round interest.		

Variety:	Cardinal Royal Mountain Ash	<i>Sorbus aucuparia 'Michred'</i>	Zone: 2
H x W:	20-35' x 15-20'	Bloom Time:	May
Foliage:	Dark green with silver-white undersides	Flower Description:	Creamy clusters
Fall Foliage:	Rusty orange	Fruit Description:	large clusters of shiny, bright red berries
Other Info:	Mountain Ash trees provide 3+ seasons of interest in the landscape. They are NOT fed on by Emerald Ash Borers.		

Variety:	Oak Leaf Mountain Ash	<i>Sorbus hybrida</i>	Zone: 4
H x W:	30' x 20'	Bloom Time:	May
Foliage:	Dark green, white beneath, oak-like	Flower Description:	Creamy clusters
Fall Foliage:	Gold to rusty orange	Fruit Description:	large clusters of orange-red berries
Other Info:	A favorite of mine, this Mountain Ash resists fire blight while providing multi-season interest.		

Variety:	Korean Mountain Ash	<i>Sorbus alnifolia</i>	Zone: 4
H x W:	30-40' x 30'	Bloom Time:	May, heavy bloom every-other year
Foliage:	Dark green, similar to ironwood or elm	Flower Description:	small clusters of 1/2", white flowers
Fall Foliage:	yellow-orange	Fruit Description:	loose clusters of 3/8 - 5/8", red berries
Other Info:	If you want a tree with ornamental appeal and a large enough crown to provide some shade, this is an excellent choice!

Variety:	Summer Charm Japanese Lilac	<i>Syringa pekinensis</i> 'DTR124'	Zone: 3
H x W:	20' x 15'	Bloom Time:	June
Foliage:	Dark green	Flower Description:	Large panicles of creamy, white flowers
Fall Foliage:	Insignificant	Fruit Description:	Seed capsules
Other Info:	Finely textured foliage grows into a shapely, round form. Creamy flowers fill the air with delicious fragrance.		

Variety:	Copper Curls Pekin Lilac	<i>Syringa pekinensis</i> 'SunDak'	Zone: 4
H x W:	20-25' x 15-20'	Bloom Time:	June
Foliage:	Dark green	Flower Description:	3-6" panicles of cream-colored flowers
Fall Foliage:	Insignificant	Fruit Description:	Showy seed heads persist into winter
Other Info:	'Copper Curls' has fantastic, exfoliating, copper-colored bark that provides significant winter interest.		

Variety:	Japanese Tree Lilac	<i>Syringa reticulata</i>	Zone: 3
H x W:	25' x 25'	Bloom Time:	June & July
Foliage:	Deep green	Flower Description:	Large panicles of creamy, white flowers
Fall Foliage:	Insignificant	Fruit Description:	Seed capsules
Other Info:	Japanese Tree Lilacs are easy, tolerant trees that thrive just about anywhere with full sun. Cherry-like bark is a bonus in winter.		

Variety:	Golden Eclipse Lilac	<i>Syringa reticulata</i> 'Golden...'	Zone: 4
H x W:	18-24' x 8-14'	Bloom Time:	June
Foliage:	two-tone green to green w/ yellow edge	Flower Description:	fragrant, cream-colored panicles
Fall Foliage:	Insignificant	Fruit Description:	Seed capsules
Other Info:	Be patient with this little tree, its variegation takes a little while to develop. It will reward you with lovely flowers and foliage.		

Variety:	Ivory Silk Japanese Lilac	<i>Syringa reticulata</i> 'Ivory Silk'	Zone: 4
H x W:	25' x 15'	Bloom Time:	Early July
Foliage:	Dark green	Flower Description:	Large panicles of creamy, white flowers
Fall Foliage:	Insignificant	Fruit Description:	Seed capsules
Other Info:	This is a great option for narrow spaces. If you love lilacs, plant tree lilacs and traditional lilacs together to extend their display.		

Variety:	Nannyberry Viburnum- Tree	<i>Viburnum lentago</i>	Zone: 2
H x W:	20' x 8-10'	Bloom Time:	May
Foliage:	Shiny green	Flower Description:	Clusters of little white flowers/yellow stamens
Fall Foliage:	Olive, gold, red, maroon- variable!	Fruit Description:	1/2", blushed green becoming very dark blue
Other Info:	This excellent ornamental tree combines the versatility of viburnums with fantastic ornamental value.
