Variety:	Autumn Brilliance Serviceberry	<i>Amelanchier x grandiflora</i>	Zone: 3
H x W:	20-25' x 15'	Bloom Time:	Late April
Foliage:	Blue-green	Flower Description:	White, very showy for a short period
Fall Foliage:	Red-orange	Fruit Description:	dark purple, attractive and delicious
Other Info:	Serviceberries are tough, adaptable plants that provide food for people and wildlife. They also have great ornamental value.		

Variety:	Rainbow Pillar Serviceberry	<i>Amelanchier canadensis 'Glenn Form'</i>	Zone: 4
H x W:	15-20' x 8-10'	Bloom Time:	Late April - early May
Foliage:	Gray-green	Flower Description:	Clusters of white, delicately scented flowers
Fall Foliage:	Bright red and burgundy	Fruit Description:	Sparse production of deep purple fruit
Other Info:	This beautiful little tree is highly adaptable and disease resistant. It is an excellent option for partially shaded areas.		

Variety:	Standing Ovation™ Serviceberry	<i>Amelanchier alnifolia 'Obelisk'</i>	Zone: 2
H x W:	15' x 4'	Bloom Time:	Late April
Foliage:	Gray-green	Flower Description:	Abundant, white flowers bloom before leaf-out
Fall Foliage:	Red-orange	Fruit Description:	Delicious berries are shades of violet and rose
Other Info:	This attractive, columnar serviceberry makes a lovely, tall hedge. Its form is showy year round. Fruits are a bird favorite.		

Variety:	Blue Beech	<i>Carpinus caroliniana</i>	Zone: 3
H x W:	20-30' x 30'	Bloom Time:	Early spring
Foliage:	Green	Flower Description:	Catkin
Fall Foliage:	Orange to red	Fruit Description:	Seeds contained in hop-like structures
Other Info:	This tree is known for its slow growth, strong wood and attractive bark. Storm breakage is a non-issue.		

Variety:	MN Strain Redbud	<i>Cercis canadensis</i>	Zone: 4
H x W:	20-30' x 20-25'	Bloom Time:	Early spring
Foliage:	Dark, blue-green	Flower Description:	Bright, rose pink, 1/2", sweet-pea like
Fall Foliage:	Bright gold	Fruit Description:	Brown pods, 2-3" wide
Other Info:	This extremely hardy, shade tolerant tree was grown from seed collected at the University of MN Landscape Arboretum.		

Variety:	Thornless Cockspur Hawthorn	<i>Crataegus crus-galli var. 'inermis'</i>	Zone: 4
H x W:	15-20' H & W	Bloom Time:	June
Foliage:	Deep, glossy green on lateral branches	Flower Description:	Single white flowers in clusters
Fall Foliage:	Rust orange	Fruit Description:	1/2" matte red, persistent
Other Info:	Hawthorns are very appealing to wildlife. They grow in all kinds of soils and are tolerant of pollution and salt.

Variety:	Amur Chokecherry	<i>Prunus maackii</i>	Zone: 2
H x W:	20-30' x 20-30'	Bloom Time:	Mid-spring
Foliage:	Medium green	Flower Description:	Small, fluffy, white panicles
Fall Foliage:	Bright gold	Fruit Description:	1/4" black, rapidly devoured by birds
Other Info:	Bight, copper-colored, exfoliating bark is this tree's finest attribute. Plant amur chokecherry for its four-season interest.		

Variety:	Showy Mountain Ash	<i>Sorbus decora</i>	Zone: 2
H x W:	20-25' x 20'	Bloom Time:	May
Foliage:	Deep, rich green	Flower Description:	Large, creamy clusters
Fall Foliage:	Orange to red	Fruit Description:	large clusters of brilliant orange
Other Info:	These beautifully shaped ornamental trees offer three seasons of significant interest. Birds adore the fruit of this Minnesota native.		

Variety:	Copper Curls Pekin Lilac	<i>Syringa pekinensis 'SunDak'</i>	Zone: 4
H x W:	20-25' x 15-20'	Bloom Time:	June
Foliage:	Dark green	Flower Description:	3-6" panicles of cream-colored flowers
Fall Foliage:	Insignificant	Fruit Description:	Showy seed heads persist into winter
Other Info:	'Copper Curls' has fantastic, exfoliating, copper-colored bark that provides significant winter interest.		

Variety:	Ivory Silk Japanese Lilac	<i>Syringa reticulata 'Ivory Silk'</i>	Zone: 4
H x W:	25' x 15'	Bloom Time:	Mid-June
Foliage:	Dark green	Flower Description:	Large panicles of creamy, white flowers
Fall Foliage:	Insignificant	Fruit Description:	Seed capsules
Other Info:	This is a great option for narrow spaces. If you love lilacs, plant tree lilacs and traditional lilacs together to extend their display.		

Variety:	Snowdance™ Japanese Tree Lilac	<i>Syringa reticulata 'Bailnce'</i>	Zone: 3
H x W:	18' x 20'	Bloom Time:	June, annually
Foliage:	Dark green	Flower Description:	Large, fragrant, creamy panicles
Fall Foliage:	Insignificant	Fruit Description:	Sterile- no seedheads
Other Info:	Flowering heavily and annually, starting at a young age, this tree lilac is an excellent choice. Great disease and pest resistance.		

Variety:	Summer Charm® Pekin Lilac	<i>Syringa pekinensis 'DTR' 124</i>	Zone: 3
H x W:	30' x 15'	Bloom Time:	June
Foliage:	Delicately textured, green	Flower Description:	Fragrant, creamy panicles
Fall Foliage:	Insignificant	Fruit Description:	Seed capsules
Other Info:	'Summer Charm' is a lovely tree; with exfoliating, copper-colored bark. Its texture is much finer than that of Japanese Tree Lilacs.		

Variety:	Summer Storm Japanese Lilac	<i>Syringa reticulata 'Summer Storm'</i>	Zone: 3
H x W:	20-25' x 12-15'	Bloom Time:	June
Foliage:	Dark green	Flower Description:	9", fragrant, creamy panicles
Fall Foliage:	Insignificant	Fruit Description:	Seed capsules
Other Info:	Quickly growing into a shapely, broadly columnar form; this is a great option for boulevards and small front yards.
